

EUCON International School, a SCACS member since its founding in 1998, is located in Saipan, the largest of the Northern Mariana Islands. Saipan, with a population of about 50,000, is a commonwealth of the United States in the western Pacific Ocean. EUCON operates under Christian Way Ministries, headquartered in Greenville.

Earlier this week Saipan was hit by a typhoon (Soudelor). The island suffered considerable damage, including damage to the EUCON campus. The house of Dr. Christian Wei, pastor and ministry director, suffered extensive damage, including the loss of the roof and significant water damage. Dr. Wei and his mother had only minor injuries; there are no reports of any other injuries to staff.

Please pray for this school, their employees and students, and the people of the island as they work to recover from this devastation. They are presently without running water, power, and much infrastructure is destroyed. Initial reports indicate that it could be 2-3 months before the island has electrical power (the power plant was underwater).

We will keep you posted as we get updates. Thank you for praying for these Christian co-laborers during their time of need. We are trusting that they will find increased opportunities to share the grace and mercy of God during the challenging days ahead.
