

Changes in the Fine Arts Manual 2020 Revision

Level I & II (see Level I & II Manual)

- Participant Involvement in groups (page 5)
- String solo clarification (page 12)
- Photography – mat color can now be neutral not just white (page 20)
- Crafts – allow kits (page 19)
- Spelling Bee – clarification of elimination once participants are reduced to 2 (pages 23-24)

Level III & IV (see Level III & IV Manual)

- Art
 - Photography – mat color can now be neutral not just white (page 31)
 - Level III Art – mat/frame is same as Level IV
- Music
 - Check number of copies needed (page 13 & table on page 18)
 - Choir, choral group and Level IV vocal solos – one song in English and one song is sacred (pages 14 & 15)
 - Percussion ensembles are allowed in large instrumental ensemble; no percussion instrument allowed in small ensemble (page 16)
 - Choir/Choral group limitations (page 16)
- Academics
 - A few tests are now grade specific (test list on page 43)
 - Spelling Bee – clarification of elimination once participants are reduced to 2 (pages 36-37)
