<p style="text-align: center;"><i>ACCURACY</i></p> correct pitches/rhythms/rests, precision, intonation (where applicable), correct interpretation of meter, key signature/accidentals		
<p style="text-align: center;"><i>TECHNIQUE</i></p> stick control, mechanics of hand/arm motion/grip/left hand/right hand, attacks/releases, pedaling execution, rolls, dampening, posture, instrument height/physical set up, mastery of rudiments-sticking patterns		
<p style="text-align: center;"><i>MUSICIANSHIP/INTERPRETATION</i></p> phrasing/shaping of musical line, expressive elements, balance, dynamics, emotional involvement, fluency/style
