Field trips are self-guided and include access to a range of animal and interactive galleries and daily experiences throughout the aquarium. Classroom programs can be added to field trip reservations but must be reserved in advance to accommodate high demand. Schools can add dissection programming to their field trip for a fee. These programs are designed to meet Next Generation Science and Common Core Standards, ensuring the experiences provided will be an extension of what is learned in the classroom.

Our mission is to provide a world-class experience that fosters the conservation and research of our natural world through environmental education and exceptional animal care, inspiring and providing fun for visitors of all ages through immersive learning and unforgettable experiences.

- By visiting our Dangerous Reef exhibit, students will learn about the shark populations that are declining with more than 70 percent of all shark and ray species facing an uncertain future. As apex predators, they help keep ocean ecosystems in balance. Ripley's Aquariums is at the forefront of shark research, working to better understand their reproductive behaviors. In 2021, Ripley's welcomed the world's first successful birth by artificial insemination of a sand tiger shark and continues to work to further this vulnerable species.
- Within our Penguin Playhouse, students will learn about our South African Penguins and how Ripley's Aquariums proudly supports the Southern African Foundation for the Conservation of Coastal Birds (SANCCOB), a nonprofit organization with a mission to reverse the decline of seabird populations through rescue and rehabilitation. The organization treats an average of 2,500 injured, sick, and oiled seabirds annually, including the endangered African penguin. Ripley's Aquariums penguin paintings, that are sold in our gift shop, donate to this cause regularly, with 50% of all proceeds going to SANCCOB's conservation efforts.

As students visit any of our Ripley's Aquariums, they will learn about the benefits and needs of being sustainable even within an attraction. Ripley's ongoing Green Campaign initiative is creating positive environmental impacts through both large and small changes in our aquariums, such as reclaiming salt water, eliminating plastic straws, incorporating solar energy, installing LED lights, and using waterless urinals which save 360,000 gallons of water per year!

Ripley's Aquariums are committed to providing the highest standard of welfare for our animals, from routine veterinary care to numerous research and conservation initiatives on both a local and global level. We aim to foster a culture of sustainability that helps build a legacy of ecological stewardship and inspires the next generation of conservationists.
